Order of the March

The Order of the March is set by East Kingdom and can be found at

http://op.eastkingdom.org/March/index.html

The order is how we set the order of precedence. Currently the order of precedence is set as follows.

- 1. Royalty and visiting foreign Royalty
- 2. Officers of the realm (kingdom officers)
- 3. The Royal Peers
 - a. Dukes and Duchesses
 - b. Counts and Countesses
 - c. Vicounts and Vicountesses
- 4. The bestowed peerages (Chiv, Laurel, Pelican)
- 5. Territorial Barons and Baronesses
 - a. Current sitting Barons and Baronesses
 - b. Retired Barons and Baronesses (by the date they were invested.)
- 6. Holders of Grants of Arms (including Court Barons who received a grant and foreign order members who received grants with their award)
- 7. Orders of High Merit (Golden Rapier, Sagittarius, Tygers Combattant, Maunche and Silver Crescent)
- 8. Court Barons and Baronesses who did not receive a grant.
- 9. Armigers (Award of Arms recipient)
- 10. Orders of Honor (Tygers Cub, QOC, Terpsichore, Troubadour, Kings order of Excellence, etc)
- 11. Members of the populace.

New Baronesses for L'Ile Dragon Dormant

In the Barony of L'ile Dragon Dormant have announced the passing of the second Baron and Baroness, Sir Angus McHaley, Baron of L'ile Dragon Dormant and Mistress Tadea Isabetta di Bruno, Baroness of L'ile Dragon Dormant to new heirs. Two sisters, Lady Jeanne de Robin and Lady Genovefa Clerica were invested as Landed Baronesses at the East Kingdom Arts and Sciences Championship in the Barony of L'ile Dragon Dormant on March 7th.

The King and Queen of the East, His Royal Majesty King Edward and Her Royal Majesty Queen Thyra were in attendance to make the transition from old to new. Her Royal Highness Princess Etheldreda Ivelchylde was also in attendance.

The History of Easter

The history of Easter reveals ancient pagan roots; this holiday was not always a Christianbased holiday. It is believed that the term Easter is literally derived from the term Eostre, the name of a Teutonic feminine deity. The latter goddess is a fertility goddess, a goddess of the spring, and the hare is sacred to her. Others believe that the word Easter is derived from hebdomada alba, a Latin term meaning white week. The latter reference is believed to be associated with the act of putting on white attire when being baptized and served as a reference for the week that Easter occurs in as well.

The association of Easter practices with the pagan goddess Eostre makes clear some of the traditions that are carried out today. The goddess Eostre was honored toward the end of the month of March, right around the time of Spring Equinox. Jakob Grimm, the author of "Deutsche Mythologie," explains that a goddess similar to Eostre was at one time mentioned by the Venerable Bede. Dr. Jonathan Young, a well-known folklorist, further asserts the mythic past associated with the holiday; the month of April was once identified as Ostaramoanoth or Eostremonat; this times the month of April immediately after Spring Equinox. Eostre is also sometimes identified as Ostara, a word rooted in the term "east," which literally means "dawn." Celebrations honoring Ostara or Eostre are ancient, and the holiday came to represent the cycle of life, death, and rebirth.

Since the holiday of Easter is about renewal and new beginnings, one should not be surprised to see people wearing brand new attire at Easter parades; this is done to reflect the notion of doing away with what is old and bringing in all that is new and fresh. Eggs are symbols of fertility, of birth, and of renewal too, and this could be why many people still paint eggs in lovely pastel colors every year. Meanwhile, the Easter Bunny may be rooted in the ancient hares held sacred to the great goddess Eostre or Ostara

Open Position - Tir Mara Web Minister

Greetings unto the Seneschals of the Crown Principality of Tir Mara, from the East Kingdom Webminister.

Dominus Gnaeus Aurelius Andronicus, current Tir Mara Deputy for the Office of the Webminister, has announced intention on stepping down in March. We have no successor at this time, so I am reaching out to you in order to fill this upcoming vacancy. Please mention this request in your Local branch meetings to have interested gentles to send their Letters of Intent with relevant list of abilities to webminister@eastkingdom.org so that we can start the transition as soon as possible.

I consider the position of Tir Mara Deputy Webminister a duplicate station akin to the East Kingdom Webminister, for the Principality. The interested gentle should be one who is willing to learn how to administer the groups under the Principality and work side-by-side with the East Kingdom Webminister.

It is my intention to have this position be as fully autonomous as possible, as if they were their own entity, in preparation for when Tir Mara becomes its own sovereign Kingdom. I will be the mentor and main resource for the Deputy to learn all of the aspects of the Office of the Webminister from the point of view as the Point of Contact for the Principality.

Duties will include (but are not limited to, and shall be expanded upon):

o Direct support of the Tir Mara Crown Principality website.

o Creation and support of the Tir Mara email forwards for the Principality Officers and Guilds.

o Creation and support of the Tir Mara email lists for the Principality.

o Having the Webministers of the Principality report directly to the Tir Mara Deputy for all issues, and requesting assistance from the East Kingdom Webminister only when necessary. o Administering the Help Desk website http://helpdesk.eastkingdom.org to address all tickets for the Principality in a timely fashion.

o Working with the Website Quality & Usability Deputy for the yearly review of each website in the Principality.

o Building a working relationship with the Principality Chronicler in order to prepare for the publication of a newsletter.

o Assisting the East Kingdom Webminister with the expansion of the services offered on the East Kingdom server in order to support the Principality Webministers.

o Be the Point of Contact for any email issues within the Principality.

o Be the Point of Contact for all Officer Listing updates and changes within the Principality.

o Reviewing the Principality branches for website presence and assisting all Local branches with their websites as necessary to keep our presence up to date.

o Additional responsibilities as necessary for the day to day working of the Principality web presence.

o Keeping records of the Webministers and Webministers-At-Large within the Principality, including modern contact information and expiration of Society Membership.

Please forward this request to any additional parties that you may know that I do not have contact information for. (I could not find contact infromation for the Canton of Artigus.)

Upcoming Projects:

o The Shire of Bois Ardent, Canton of Artigus, Shire of La Selve d'Aure, and Shire of Le Dragonet do not have a website on the East Kingdom Server. It will be the Tir Mara Deputy to contact these groups, have them designate a Webminister that then Warrants with this Office, and establish a website on the East Kingdom Server. With this project I will be able to teach the Deputy how to, from start to finish, every step of the way the creation of these groups in the Æther.

o Making certain that all Local branches are on the East Kingdom server using the http://branch.eastkingdom.org designation, with no sub-branches being held as http://branch.eastkingdom.org/sub-branch as no group should be hosted in a directory under another group.

o All Principality branch websites have to be hosted on the East Kingdom server if they are not already. Any 'vanity' website names will need to be pointers to the official website and will not host duplicate information.

o Establishing a policy and procedure of Office Succession for the Principality in order to avoid any loss of service to the groups that the Tir Mara Deputy would be overseeing.

o The websites of eilean.eastkingdom.org, lyndhaven.eastkingdom.org and

ynysygwaed.eastkingdom.org do not currently have a Warranted Webminister for their website on record. This project will include contacting the previous Webminister (if any) and the Seneschal of the Local branch to resolve this issue, including following the steps for suspension and removal as listed in the East Kingdom Webminister Policies Handbook if necessary. Establishing a new Local Webminister or having a Webminister-At-Large assigned to the website will also be part of this project.
