### **Principality Update**

As you all may or may not know, the requirements to go principality are 100 paid members of the SCA. At our May meeting we had 259.

Our numbers for peerages are still down in the Order of Chivalry, but we have 8 Laurels, 6 of which are active, and 11 Pelicans, 8 of which are active.

However, we still need to increase the size of our rattan fighting base. A large rattan fighting base will ensure that our principality tournaments see a satisfactory number of fighters of high caliber participating, and this will be a determining factor in whether or not the Northern Shores is seen as able to sustain a principality. Hopefully, during the winter months, we can encourage more fighters to come out and play. OTC challenges which were at one time taking place in the Barony of Ruantallan, are about to start in Le Dragonet and Barony L'ile du Dragon Dormant. There has also been talk of a roving fighter practice between the Barony of Havres des Glaces, The Barony of L'ile du Dragon Dormant, Le Dragonet, and a group in Ealdomere. Hopefully our enthusiasm in the winter months will be reflected in our attendance in the summer months at events including Lyndhaven War Camp and the Great Northeastern War.

So we encourage as many potential fighters as possible to armour up and hit something!

# Scribal Arts Lecture in Halifax, Nova Scotia (Ruantallan)

## The Saint Mary's Salzinnes Antiphonal: a Medieval Manuscript in Halifax

On Wednesday, February 8 at 7:00pm, Judy Dietz, Associate Curator of Historical European Art at the Art Gallery of Nova Scotia and Saint Mary's University graduate student, will give an enlightening talk about the Saint Mary's Salzinnes Antiphonal, a unique and valuable artifact from the Patrick Power Library's rare book collection.

A liturgical manuscript from 1554, written in Latin, the Salzinnes Antiphonal reveals a unique insight into the spiritual and cultural lives of the nuns of the Cistercian Abbey of Salzinnes in Namur, present day Belgium. It features text and music, full-page illuminations of biblical scenes and, of particular rarity, full-length representations of 34 nuns together with their names in regional script who lived in the abbey.
