### Aurora Borealis - Konungs skuggsjá Chapter One

Baroness Tadea Isabetta di Bruno

Chapter one of the Aurora Borealis – Konungs skuggsjá is designed to help you learn more about the landed Baron's and Baronesses of Ti Mara. Each of them has answered 5 simple questions with the purpose of showing how similar and how different each of us is. Listed in order of Investiture they are:

Barony of Ruantallan: Baron Donal O'Neill and Baroness Allessandra Francesca di Milano Barony of Havre des Glaces: Baron Arthur de Beaumont and Baronne Shadiyah al-Zahra Barony of L'Ile du Dragon Dormant: Baron Angus McHaley and Baroness Tadea Isabetta di Bruno

#### **Chapter One:**

How long have you been in the SCA?

Donal: Since the spring of 1999 Allessandra: January 1993

Arthur: I first started in the SCA in 1993, so it's now been almost 19 years. Shadiyah: I went to my first event on November 96, or was it 95? I'm not sure. It's a long time ago!! I was hooked right there. It was a wonderful night!

Angus: Since 1999 Tadea: It was either 1996 or 1997. I can never remember. However I do remember meeting Alessandra at my very first event!!!

#### What is your main goal as a landed Baron/Baroness?

Arthur: I would say that having the pleasure of representing our Barony in the Pennsic procession last year was really amazing.

Shadiyah: It's been only 1 1/2 year, and many moments where memorable. But I must say that having the privilege to actually give an Award of Arms in Their Majesties' Names at the last Feste des Glaces was really out of the ordinary

Angus: Walking off the field at Pennsic after having won the unbelted battle with two other members of our Barony.

Tadea: Hearing people say "oh yes!!" when I ask "Did you have fun today and will you come back and play with us again?"

### If you could give one piece of advice, what would it be?

Donal: Run!! Alessandra: Don't sweat the little things
