They encourage those unsure of their new abilities, and above all Sheppard a flock excited by what they see but still unsure of their place in a group.

Gratitude and help should be given to a groups Chatelaine. Their job is to gather our new generation and assist them with finding their spot within this beautiful game. It is not always an easy job but it possibly the most important position of any group. I encourage everyone reading this article to seek out their local Chatelaine and give them the greatest gift of this game, your time and assistance. Many hands make light work and newcomers will always remember kindness shown to them.

Who was the first person you remember meeting at an event?

Martin: Ursion de Gui, Maitresse Alisay and Baron Godfroy de Falaise

Brunegarde: The first people I met at an event (The demo of Domaine Maizerets) were Éllégon de Millambre, Pellandre di le frère and Leannan MacGowan.

Cat Lennox: Lady Falcona was my introduction to the SCA. We were at BBB II.

What is the most important quality in a good chatelaine?

Martin: That is more complicated because it takes SEVERAL in my opinion ... they must have tact, humor, love people and be curious nature

Cat Lennox: I believe the most important quality in a good Chatelaine should be to have a deep joy for the SCA and a want to share this with others.

If you could have one thing that would make your job as Chatelaine easier, what would it be?

Martin: Nothing. It is a wonderful office to hold but at the same time heavy to carry.

Cat Lennox: The one thing that would make my job as Chatelaine easier would be more opportunities in our province to put on Demos that would actually have positive recruitment possibilities. (Like Halcon in NS)

What is your favorite memory as Chatelaine?

Martin: Every moment as a Chartelaine has been fun, but meeting new friends and seeing them find their passion as part of the group is great. It is watching them find their style and watching as new friendships are created that I enjoy the most.

Cat Lennox: My only favorite memory as a Chatelaine so far, is having the mother of a young boy telling us at the Demo we put on at the Gathering of the Scots that she would definitely be contacting us about when and where we held events or she`d never hear the end of it from him because he was so excited and interested in what we do.

List 3 tips you would give to any new Chatelaine?

Martin: First, help people learn about the world around them. Find out their personal interests. Secondly, develop a love of travel so you can help other discover their new world and all that surrounds them. Finally, and most importantly, is enjoy to fully enjoy and the world that surrounds.

Cat Lennox: I don't have any tips yet as I am a new Chatelaine, but I'll take all the advice I can get! :)
