Aurora Borealis - Konungs skuggsjá Chapter Four

In the past year Tir Mara has been graced with Royal presence more often than not and, between Crown Tourney Ruantallan, Feste des Glaces in Havres des Galces, and both All Things Scribal and King's and Queen's Rapier in Dragon Dormant, we saw many new visitors to our shores. I have found that with so many new faces comes the all too common question of "How should I address them?" This chapter of the King's Mirror will help us learn how to identify and address people when we meet them.

King/Queen: Your Majesty – There are several different Coronets worn by the King and Queen of the

East. However you will always be able to find someone who can point them out.

Prince/Princess: Your Highness – In the East, our Prince and Princesses generally wear a golden coronet

with 4 Eastern Tygers.

Duke/Duchess: Your Grace – Coronet with Strawberry Leaves

Count/Countess: Your Excellency – Coronet with embattlement edging

Viscount/Viscountess: Your Excellency – Cornet with many "Pearls" or with one exaggerated point

Order or the Laurel: Master/Mistress (Name of Person) – Generally Medallion with a Laurel Wreath

Order of the Pelican: Master/Mistress (Name of Person) – Generally Medallion with a Pelican

Order of the Chivalry: Sir (Name) – White belt worn around the waist

Master (Name) – White baldric worn over one shoulder

Baron/Baroness: Your Excellency - Cornet with six "pearls" (this applies to both Landed and Court

Baoron/Baronesses)

AOA: Lord/Lady

No Award of Rank: M'Lord/M'Lady

When in doubt it politely ask them how they should be addressed. Remember, even the most experienced SCAdians still have trouble remembering all of the different titles. If you do not feel comfortable asking than M'Lord, M'Lady works fine.
