Words from the Tir Mara Seneschal

The Tir Mara Curia, Landed Barons/Baronesses and Peers of Tir Mara have been meeting with the Tir Mara Prince and Princess regarding the Crown Principality. Here's the status of where we are now.

1. We have a working document that will become our Laws for Tir Mara. They are in draft form and have been submitted to the East Kingdom Seneschal, Prince and Princess and King and Queen for review. Once they have reviewed and returned the document, we will be releasing them to the populace for your input. There will be a list of people who will accept feedback within a set period of time. Remember that as a Principality we are still subject to East Kingdom Law and SCA Corpora and cannot override anything in their Laws. Once the feedback has been received and we have completed another revision the document will be submitted for final approval. When it is approved by Kingdom, it comes back and gets voted on by the members of the SCA in Tir Mara.

2. Lady Mariotta drafted the financial policies. As with the Laws for Tir Mara, the Financial Policies are going through a review with the East Kingdom Exchequer, Prince and Princess and King and Queen. Once they have reviewed and returned the document, we will be releasing them to the populace for your input. The same process will be in place for the financial policies as those for the Laws of Tir Mara.

3. We are in the process of setting up an email account for receiving ideas for Armigerous (AOA) and non armigerous awards. We will need to submit badges/heraldry with names for approval with the college of heralds. We will be looking primarily for 4 awards, AOA level award for Fighting, A&S, Service and Children. Other non armigerous award suggestions can be submitted as well. Dates and deadlines will be given when we have the structure set up to accept submissions. Start brainstorming now, but please hold off sending in submissions until we have the structure in place to handle this.

4. We have started to collect regalia for the different championships and the Coronet. There will be a list of other required/desired regalia, with the designs for the heraldry and the style of regalia. For now, if you have any questions, please contact Mistress Gwenhwyfar Dinas Emrys, until a chamberlain is appointed.

I'd like to thank everyone who has worked on getting these documents ready for release, especially Lady Mariotta and Sir Gareth.
